



Postgraduate Research Application Process

1. Contact the Post-Graduate Research Coordinator (PGRC) at the School of Education (s.kalyuga@unsw.edu.au), and express your interest in applying as a higher degree research student. The PGRC will advise you of further requirements such as a copy of your CV and research proposal.

2. Upon submitting all relevant documents, the PGRC will consult School academics about your case, and within one week, you will hear about your application. If you are eligible, your details will be given to your potential supervisor, and you will be invited to consult with her/him directly.

3. Your potential supervisor will advise you on how to further develop the research proposal for submission with a formal application to the Graduate Research School (GRS). She/he will also advise you of whether or not you need a joint or co-supervisor. This process is to be completed in no more than 2 weeks.

4. Once all documentation has been pre-approved by your supervisor/s, you are to submit a formal application to the GRS with your potential supervisor's name/s in the corresponding section in the application form.

5. The GRS will advise you of the outcome of your application.
