# MEd Program Plan

For students commencing in 2019

## TESOL Specialisation

The program consists of six core courses, including the option of 25 days of supervised professional practice in an intensive English language setting or mainstream school or other educational organisation with EALD classes, plus research methods and a capstone project (48 units of credit).

Students select six courses from the following list, including:

- EDST5150 Teacher Language Awareness (6 UOC)
- EDST5325 TESOL Professional Practice (6 UOC)
- EDST5440 Adv TESOL Method (6 UOC)
- EDST5441 Adv TESOL Curriculum & Assessment (6 UOC)
- EDST5452 Issues in Language Education (6 UOC)
- EDST5454 Developing Literacies (6 UOC)

AND

- EDST5448 Educational Research – Offered in Term 1 Term 2

AND

- EDST5888 Project (6 UOC) – Must be done in last term of study (offered in each term and during Summer)

*Note: Students who need an accredited specialist qualification in TESOL for teaching in Australia, and have no prior studies in TESOL must take EDST5150, EDST5440, EDST5441 & EDST5325.*
